1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 16.10.2024, the petitioner have joined the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 16.10.2024, following order has been passed: -

*‘Status report dated 03.10.2024 in the form  
of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police,*



*Crime-II, Gurugram, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.*

2. *Heard.*

3. *SI Jora Singh, Investigating Officer of the case, present in Court and on query, he has stated that except for the disclosure statement, there is nothing on record connecting the petitioner with the crime.*

4. *In these circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.*

5. *List on 13.11.2024.'*

4. Learned State counsel on instructions, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 16.10.2024, passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 16.10.2024, is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS). Further the petitioner is directed to join



investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; they will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

- 6. The petition stands allowed.
- 7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
