ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent-HSVP, with reference to our order dated 22.08.2024, submits that vide an e-mail dated 30.08.2024, he has got instructions that the matter is under active consideration of the competent authority. Thus, he submits that let the petition be disposed of, at this stage, to enable the respondent authorities to deal with the concerns/grievances of the petitioners, as sought to be raised in the petition. And pass necessary orders on the representations submitted by them, dated 02.08.2024 (P-17) and 13.08.2024 (P-19), in accordance with law. Further, he submits that before any such orders are passed, they shall be heard, for which, a formal communication shall be issued, well in advance.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is in agreement with the course suggested by learned counsel for the respondent-HSVP and submits that let this petition be disposed of, in terms of the statement made by him. However, it is urged, for a considerable time has already elapsed, the authorities be directed to do the needful, within a specified time.



In response, learned counsel for the respondent-HSVP submits that appropriate orders shall be passed within a period of two weeks from today.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties.

This Court is sanguine that the authorities shall look into the matter in the right earnest. And the appropriate orders shall be passed within the time indicated by learned counsel for the respondent-HSVP.

Needless to assert that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on the merits of the case of either party, for, as indicated above, the competent authority shall examine the concerns/grievances of the petitioners, strictly in accordance with law.
