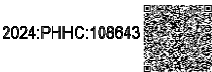

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner, who is working as General Manager in the Punjab State Cooperative Bank Limited, with the apprehension that respondent No.4-Jagdish Singh Sidhu, holding the Current Duty Charge of Additional Managing Director (Banking), who is junior to the petitioner, might be promoted by superseding the petitioner in a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Bank to be held on 28.08.2024. Further, orders dated 15.01.2021 and 22.01.2021 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) have also been impugned whereby current duty charge was given to respondent No.4.



2. Since as on date, no promotion order to the post of Additional Managing Director (Banking) has been issued, therefore, the instant petition is pre-mature.

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as pre-mature with liberty to the petitioner to avail legal remedy in accordance with law at an appropriate stage and challenge the aforesaid orders in a subsequent writ petition in accordance with law, if so required.
