PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. On the last date, following order was passed:-

“On the last date of hearing, notice of motion was issued by this Court and respondents were directed to file their respective replies but the same have not been filed.

Both the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 have submitted that the matter has been compromised between the parties amicably.

In view of the above, the parties are directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their respective statements with regard to compromise/settlement on 12.01.2024.

The Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court is directed to submit a report along with copies of statements of the parties on or before the next date of hearing containing the following information as well:-

(i) Number of persons arrayed as accused in FIR;

(ii) Whether any accused is proclaimed offender?

(iii) Status of trial/proceedings.

(iv) Whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary, and without any coercion or undue influence.

List on 19.04.2024, for awaiting the report.”

2. Pursuant thereto, report from Chief Judicial Magistrate, (NRI Court). Jalandhar has been received wherein none of the parties have turned up for recording their statement qua the compromise observing as under:-

“1. Kindly refer to the order dated 08.12.2023 passed in CRM-M-42923- 2023 by the Hon'ble High Court in case titled as "Gaurav Kapoor @ Garry Kapoor @ Rishu Vs. State of Punjab and others".

2. It is submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.12.2023 none of the party turned up before the trial Court for recording their statement qua the compromise.”

3. In view of the fact that none has appeared before the trial Court for recording their statement in view of the compromise, present petition stands dismissed.
