HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, by way of present petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent, alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 27.05.2022 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 2952 of 2015.

[2] At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that principal amount stands paid, however, interest has not been paid.

[3] Learned counsel for the respondent(s), on instructions from Sh. Gurdeep Singh, Superintendent, Water Resources Department, Punjab, assures / undertakes that the needful shall be done within a period of one week from today.

[4] In view of aforesaid assurance / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[5] **Disposed off as not pressed.**

[6] Rule stands discharged.

[7] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition by instituting an appropriate application, and on the day of its listing, the officer concerned shall remain present in Court besides it, he / she shall bear the costs of Rs.1,00,000/- towards litigation expenses incurred by the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
