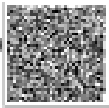
NIDHI GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of *Mandamus* to official respondents No. 2 to 4, to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 10 and their accomplices.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ludhiana (Rural), Punjab, to consider and take a final decision on the representation dated 26.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Kunwarbir Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 and submits that he has 'no objection' in case the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage, is accepted.



After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without going into the merits of the present writ petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ludhaina (Rural), to forthwith consider the grievance(s) raised by the petitioner in the aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) and take action thereupon as he deems fit, in accordance with law, within a period of 06 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
