GURBIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The prayer in this petition under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.23 dated 11.03.2024 under Sections 307/326/323/324 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2024. He has produced a copy of statements of complainant Palwinder Singh and his wife Smt. Shinder Kaur as PW-1 and PW-2, respectively recorded in the trial Court whereby both of them have turned hostile. Copy of statements is taken on record.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and files the custody certificate, which is taken on record. She has not disputed the above said fact.
5. I have heard the submission of the learned counsel for the

petitioner, learned State counsel and have gone through the paper-book.

6. Keeping in view the fact that complainant and his wife have not supported the version of the prosecution so no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

7. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
