1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 22.02.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-3375-2022.

2. In response, compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Prem Singh, Joint Director, Animal Husbandry and Dairying Department, Haryana, Panchkula on behalf of respondents has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

As per the report, the petitioner has been granted the benefit of revised Ist ACP and 2nd ACP. Learned State counsel further, on instructions, informs that the financial benefits shall be released to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
