Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once, the selection of the petitioner is prior to 01.01.2004, the petitioner is to be treated under the Old Pension Scheme and not under the New Pension Scheme. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that delay on the part of the respondents in issuing the appointment order cannot take away the right of the petitioner especially, when the selection was finalized prior to 01.01.2004.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in his representation dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, DAG, Punjab,



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who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, representation dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P/6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as certain relevant facts have come into operation after the filing of the present petition, the petitioner may kindly be allowed to supplement his representation dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P/6).

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case, any supplementary representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of 04 weeks from today, the same will also be taken into consideration by the respondents while deciding his representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
