This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release the benefits to the petitioner as per Clause 11 of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016, Annexure P-1 & P-2, and letter dated 10.05.2018, Annexure P-4, issued by Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the second respondent. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 09.07.2024, Annexure P-5, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, appearing on advance notice, submits that the pending legal notice shall be decided by the second respondent, expeditiously.

5. In view thereof, without going into merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent/Director General, Elementary School Education, to consider and decide the pending legal notice dated 09.07.2024, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
6. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioner.
