In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for after his retirement are not being released by the respondents even though, the criminal proceedings, which were initiated against the petitioner have already been stayed by the competent Court of law and even otherwise, as no charges have been framed in the said criminal proceedings, the same cannot be taken into account for withholding of the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 18.06.2024 (Annexure P-9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, representation dated 18.06.2024 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be extended to him, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
