1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 read with Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to direct the respondents to grant interim bail for a period of three months to the petitioner.
2. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the State of Haryana has referred to the medical report of the petitioner and the following observations have been made in the said communication/medical report.

“Inmate Patient (CT) Kunal S/o Vijay, age 23 Years, male was admitted at District Jail Sonipar on 12.09.2024 and he was medically examined by Jail Medical Officer on duty. At the time of admission in Jail, Kunal told about past history of gun shot injury in 2020 as well as Surgery on left knee 1 year back to the Jail Medical Officer on duty. A lacerated wound on left foot (Bandage present) was also present. Although previous treatment record of inmate was not present at the time of admission. During his confinement at jail, he had visited jail Hospital OPD several times with complaints of pain in left foot, cough & cold and fever and he was given treatment accordingly by the Jail Medical



Officer on duty and specialist Doctor from Civil Hospital Sonipat during their jail visit on weekly basis.

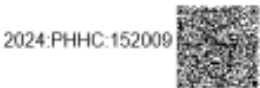
On 16.10.2024, inmate patient was sent to PGIMS, Rohtak in Ortho department by Jail M.O with chief complaint of pain in left foot specialist doctor examined the inmate patient and advised X-ray of left knee and left ankle (Both AP and Lateral) and inmate was advised for follow-up along with X-ray reports on his next visit. On 23.10.2024, inmate was sent to PGIMS, Rohtak in Ortho department for follow-up. Seen by Specialist doctor, prescribed medicines for 1 month and dressing was done. Inmate was advised to take BPS (Burns & Plastic Surgery) opinion.

On 29.10.2024, inmate was sent to Burns and Plastic Surgery department as advised by Specialist doctor in Ortho department on inmate's last visit. Seen by specialist doctor regular dressing was done and Inmate was told to come in next OPD alongwith old treatment records.

On 06.11.2024, inmate's previous treatment record was received at this jail from District Jail, Panipat and subsequently inmate was sent to PGIMS, Rohtak in Burns and Plastic Surgery department on 14.11.2024. Seen by specialist doctor and inmate was told to come for Surgery after two weeks if OT is available he will be admitted.

Now inmate patient will be sent to PGIMS, Rohtak in Burns and Plastic Surgery department on 28.11.2024 for Surgery admission.”

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.



- 5. If the surgery is to be performed on the petitioner, the process shall be expedite.
- 6. Pending application stands also disposed of.
