AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

Vide order dated 23.07.2024, on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellants, a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by Rs.25,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by Rs.20,000/- and not by Rs.25,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Learned counsel for the appellants states that agreed amount be released in favour of appellant No.1. It is further undertaken that in case in future any claim is raised by any other appellant(s), the appellant No.1 shall indemnify the said claimant(s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Rajbala wd/o Sh. Rishi Pal, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 04.10.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the



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date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Pending applications, if any shall stand disposed of.
