This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 23.05.2022 passed in CWP-9203-2022.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of Jaswinder Singh Chahal, Chief Engineer, filed in the Registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 23.05.2022 passed in CWP-9203-2022 has been complied with and the claim of the petitioners has been rejected and necessary orders dated 19.02.2024 and 18.04.2024 have been passed.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the orders passed by the respondents.
