Prayer in the instant application filed under Section 151 of CPC is for placing on record affidavit of the petitioner along with resolution dated 08.07.2024.

Allowed as prayed for.

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1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to pay gratuity and leave encashment to the petitioner along with 12% interest and for quashing the reply dated 16.05.2022 (Annexure P-4), whereby payment of gratuity and leave encashment to the petitioner has been declined.

2. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been resolved between the petitioner and respondent No.3 vide



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resolution dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-7) and in terms of the said settlement, the necessary payments shall be released to the petitioner by respondent No.3.

3. In view of the settlement between petitioner and respondent No.3 vide resolution dated 08.07.2024 (Annexure P-7), the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

4. It is made clear that the parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the abovesaid resolution.
