1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.54 dated 25.07.2024, registered under Sections 108 and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023 (equivalent of Sections 306 and 34 of IPC), at Police Station GRP, Bathinda, District Government Railway Police, Bathinda.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.08.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. In compliance of order dated 23.08.2024 passed by this Court, reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Govt. Railway Police Punjab, Sub-Division, Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State in Court today and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 23.08.2024, passed



by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
