The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional honorarium of ₹10,000 per month in view of the notification dated 13.04.2022, Annexure P-2 and Amended Teachers Transfer Policy 2023 dated 09.08.2023, Annexure P-3 and on the basis of parity, keeping in view the similar orders dated 30.04.2024 and 21.05.2024, Annexure P-9 and P-10 respectively, passed by this Court.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh



representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be decided by respondents no. 2 and 3 expeditiously.
- 5. In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a representation before the concerned respondents within a period of two weeks from today. In case any such representation is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be decided by respondent nos.2 and 3-Director General, Secondary/Elementary Education, as the case may be, by passing a speaking order thereupon, within a period of three months of receiving the representation.
