1. The prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.1572 dated 26.12.2023 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat, Haryana.

2. In compliance of the previous order, status report dated 03.09.2024 by way of affidavit of Mr. Rajbir Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Panipat has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same as petitioner is ready to surrender before the concerned trial Court. It is further submitted that petitioner would be satisfied if his bail application may be decided in a time bound manner.

4. In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the Court of concerned Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 10 days from today and his bail application be decided within a period of 10 days from the date of filing the same.
