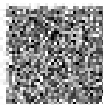

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents authorities to grant the due gratuity amount of Rs.4,46,306/- + 18% per annum interest to the petitioner in lieu of service rendered by him at respondent-Society from 20.03.1992 to 21.11.2005.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 06.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) to respondent No.1-Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice dated 06.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) is considered and decided by respondent No.1-Registrar, Cooperative Societies,

Haryana in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.



3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only, at this stage.
4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued in this regard.
5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from respondents No.1 and 2 and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana/competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 06.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
