SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of instant petition filed under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, petitioner has approached this Court for extension of time by four months for conclusion of the arbitration proceedings.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that an Arbitrator was appointed by this Court vide order dated 24.02.2022, Annexure P-1, with the consent of the parties. As the proceedings could not be concluded within the statutory period, on a petition moved by the petitioner, by order dated 15.03.2024, Annexure P-8, time period to conclude the proceedings was extended by six months. Counsel submits that the arbitral proceedings are now at the final stage.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Aman Bahri, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He has received instructions from Mr. Navneet Singh, SE, PWD (B&R), Ambala Circle, PWD (B&R), District Ambala, Haryana to submit that the respondents do not have objection in case the time period is extended.
5. Accordingly, petition is allowed.
6. Time for conclusion of the arbitral proceedings is extended by a period of four months from the date a copy of the order is received by the learned Arbitrator.
