1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct proper and fair investigation in a complaint dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) filed by the petitioner against the respondents.

On advance notice, Mr. I.P.S Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab has appeared on behalf of official respondents and on instructions from ACP Gurpreet Singh submits that a representation dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) was received by the police, however, it was found that no cognizable offence was made out. Consequently, the representation dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-5) has already been consigned to record room and no action has been taken on the same.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the present petition is accordingly, disposed of.
4. Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail

his alternative remedies if any, in accordance with law.
