1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 05.04.2024 passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur, in Civil Suit no.533 of 2018 titled as “Nachhater Singh vs. Karam Singh”.
