1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for directing the respondents No.1 & 2 to register an FIR against the private respondent no.3 on representation/complaint dated 26.07.2022 (Annexure P-7).
2. In compliance of the order dated 15.03.2024, a status report filed by way of an affidavit of Dr. Ravjot Grewal, IPS, Sr. Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib is taken on record.
