As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- over and above the amount of Rs.11,39,000/- already awarded vide a subsequent order dated 15.02.2018 passed in review application, is awarded to the appellants. Counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellants 1 and 2 in the ratio of 40:60, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques; one in the sum of Rs.1,60,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Smt. Meena Rani Wd/o Shri Kapil Kumar and the other in the sum of Rs.2,40,000/- favouring appellant No.2-Garvita D/o Kapil Kumar, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of six weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the counsel for the appellant/appellants.

Appeal stands disposed of.
