Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to investigate into commission of theft, cheating, trespass and misappropriation of money by respondents No.4 to 8 who illegally trespassed into the house of the petitioner and stole domestic items and a sum of Rs.55,000/- from the possession of the petitioner and also withdrew a sum of Rs.3,80,000/- from the account of deceased Lalji (Taya Ji) of the petitioner after his demise without the consent of the nominee of the account i.e. the petitioner and also threatening the life and liberty of the petitioner and further direct to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to register FIR under appropriate Sections against respondents No.4 to 8 for commission of said offence. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.2 to take appropriate action according to law upon the complaint dated 24.06.2024.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedy as available to him under law.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
