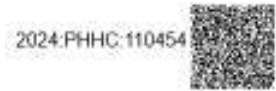

1. Petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, to quash the enquiry proceedings pending before Deputy Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau Range, Ludhiana, Punjab (respondent No. 4 herein).

1.1 A further prayer has been made by petitioner to stay the said enquiry pending before the respondent No.4.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to raise objections before the Vigilance Bureau or before the trial Court, as the case may be in accordance with law; as per observations made by Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure P-24) in CWP-17211-2023 filed by the petitioner itself.



3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
