1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take the petitioner on the pay roll of Municipal Corporation, Karnal as Safai Karamchari in view of the policy dated 06.09.2019 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Government of Haryana and further for directing respondent No.4 to decide the appeal (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was working as a Safai Karamchari and he had filed an appeal before respondent No.4-Joint Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Karnal for taking him on the pay roll of Municipal Corporation, Karnal but the said appeal has not been decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4-Joint Commissioner,



Municipal Corporation, Karnal to consider and decide the aforesaid appeal filed by the petitioner in a time bound manner. He also submitted that similarly situated person, namely, Ram Kumar had also filed a similar kind of petition pertaining to same organization, which was disposed of by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 11.02.2022 vide Annexure P-9.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A. G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case direction is issued to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Joint Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Karnal to consider and decide the appeal (Annexure P-6), which the learned counsel for the petitioner is stated to have been filed, strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
