1. The petitioner has been issued a passport which is valid upto 2031. He complains that there is an error in recording his date of birth in the passport. Therefore, he prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to rectify the aforesaid mistake in recording his date of birth. The petitioner has attached various documents to support his claim.

2. The learned counsel representing the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh submits that if the petitioner files an appropriate application along with the relevant documents, the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh will consider petitioner's claim.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application along with supporting documents which shall be considered by Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh, within six weeks from the date of its receipt.
