1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide rapat No.24 dated 14.08.2020 as cross version in FIR No.305 dated 01.08.2020 under Sections 307, 336, 452, 201, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (later on Section 307 IPC was added vide rapat No.33 dated 17.08.2020) and (later on Section 307 and 452 IPC were removed/reduced vide rapat No.15 dated 2.5.2021) registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.
2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran has been filed on behalf of respondent-State and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that in compliance of the

order dated 22.08.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

4. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 22.08.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
