1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondent no.5 to decide the application seeking interim relief/main OA No.060/153/2023, which is pending before it for 20.09.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pleadings in the matter were complete on 05.09.2023, however, matter has not yet been heard and finally adjudicated upon thus causing irreparable loss to petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 3 (on advance notice) submits that no adjournment whatsoever had been sought by the respondent before learned Tribunal and arguments would be addressed on the date it is taken up.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the matter, we do not find any ground to direct learned Tribunal to decide the matter in a time bound manner as we are sanguine that the matter would be taken up and decided in accordance with law by learned Tribunal keeping in view the exigencies of the matter. It is open to the petitioner to make a mention before learned Tribunal on the date fixed after intimation and with consent of learned counsel for respondents.
