Main Case

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of
the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the
respondents for violating the order dated 08.02.2021 passed in CRM-M-
42773-2020.
2. Present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner for
alleged violation of settlement arrived at between the parties in mediation
proceedings during pendency of an application for grant of anticipatory bail.
The settlement itself is containing contingencies; to be fulfilled on the part
of both sides. Certain conditions are of the kind, the compliance qua which
was supposed to be continuing even till today. However, even learned
counsel for the petitioner has not disputed that the petitioner could also not
fulfill certain conditions on account of default on the part of the respondent.

3. Since, the disputed question of facts are involved in the present case, therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to proceed further in the present petition any more. Hence, the same is dismissed.

4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
