1. By way of instant revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for setting aside the order dated 30.08.2022, Annexure P-1, passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Divison), in case titled "***Gopal Singh Vs.
