SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 26.05.2019, Annexure P-1, whereby the revision petition preferred by the petitioner was dismissed by respondent No.1.

2. After hearing the parties, this Court passed the following order on 16.10.2024:-

“By making a reference to order dated 23.09.2015/06.10.2015, Annexure P-11, Mr. Tewari submits that the application for restoration was accepted and the appeal was restored to its original number. He submits that surprisingly the same application for restoration was subsequently dismissed vide order dated 11.07.2016, Annexure



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P-15, and the revision against the said order has been declined vide impugned order, Annexure P-1. He submits that there is a confusion in the record. State counsel is directed to produce the original record and to assist the Court List on 12.11.2024. To be shown in the urgent cause list.”

3. In deference to the previous order, State counsel has produced the original official record and submits that the factual position, as depicted in the above reproduced order, cannot be disputed.
4. In view of the above, there is no option left with the Court except to set aside the impugned orders dated 26.05.2019, Annexure P-1 as well as dated 11.07.2016, Annexure P-15, passed by respondent No.2.
5. Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of. Orders dated 26.05.2019 and 11.07.2016, Annexures P-1 and P-15, respectively, are quashed. Matter is remitted to Deputy Registrar Co-operative Societies, Kurukshetra to adjudicate the appeal on merits. Parties are directed to appear before Deputy Registrar Co-operative Societies, Kurukshetra, on 09.12.2024 at 10:00 am, who will proceed further in accordance with law. He is directed to decide the appeal within a period of six months from the date of communication of copy of his order.
