1. The instant petition, as cast under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C., proffers the hereinafter extracted relief, as craved by the petitioner, inasmuch as, quashing of the FIR No.110 dated 18.12.2021, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at P.S. Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
2. Status report dated 14.01.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh. Bikramjeet Singh Brar, DSP, Sub-Division Zirakpur, has been filed, by the learned State counsel, which is taken on record.
3. Number of disputed questions of facts have been raised in the instant petition, which cannot be adjudicated under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to entertain the instant petition. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to raise all such pleas before the trial Court concerned at appropriate state.
