NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 14.05.2019 (Annexure P-8) vide which the representation of the petitioner has been rejected and further sought a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to re-examine/re-evaluate the answer keys/answers of the questions set in the examination by constituting a Board of Experts and after re-evaluating the answers of questions correctly, promote the petitioner to the post of Senior Executive Engineer from the date the juniors of the petitioners have been promoted.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has submitted detailed representation dated 20.02.2019, however, the same has been rejected by the respondent-Corporation by

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passing a cryptic and non-speaking order dated 14.05.2019 which reads as under :-

“In this regard, on the subject cited above, you are informed that your representation dated 29.03.2019 addressed to Hon’ble C.M.D./PSPCL has been considered by the competent officer and he does not agree with the same.

This is being issued by order of the competent officer”

- 3. Having faced with this situation, learned counsel for the respondents submits that they shall reconsider the matter and pass a fresh order.
- 4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the instant petition is disposed of.
- 5. The respondents shall reconsider and decide the matter of the petitioner within a period of 03 months from today.
