1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to decide her representation dated 17.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) and complaint/grievance dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-12).

2. The petitioner claims that she is widowed daughter of Sh. Wasu @ Basu Yadav. Mr. Basu Yadav was working with Punjab Engineering College, Chandigarh and he passed away on 24.04.2010. At the time of his death, he was getting pension. After his death, his wife started getting family pension, who also passed away on 09.04.2013. The petitioner's husband also passed away on 07.04.2002. She claims that after the death of her mother, she being widowed daughter of deceased



employee is entitled to family pension.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate and Mr. Anil Sharma, Advocate & Mr. Mayank Sharma, Advocate accept notice on behalf of respondent-State, respondent No.2 and respondents No.3 and 4-U.T. Chandigarh respectively, and waive service.
5. With consent of learned counsel for the parties, the case is taken up for final disposal.
6. Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate submits that representation/complaint of the petitioner shall be addressed within three months from today.
7. In the wake of statement of Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate, the present petition stands disposed of.
