NAMIT KUMAR J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the payment of arrears of revised pension w.e.f. 01.01.2016 to 30.06.2021 and enhancement of dearness allowance @ 119% w.e.f. 01.07.2015, @ 125% w.e.f. 01.01.2016 and subsequent hikes in DA e.g. @ 38% w.e.f. 01.07.2022, @ 42% w.e.f. 01.01.2023, @ 46% w.e.f. 01.07.2023 and @ 50% w.e.f. 01.01.2024 at par with Central Government Pattern as recommended by 6th Pay Commission. Further a writ of certiorari has been sought for quashing the action/order dated 26.12.2023 (Annexure P-10) circulated by respondents whereby the benefit of arrears to the petitioners has been delayed without any reason.



After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail other legal remedies, in accordance with law including filing of a contempt petition for violation of the order dated 20.09.2023 in CWP No.20537 of 2023, titled as “Boota Singh and others vs State of Punjab and others”, which was preferred by the petitioners themselves along with other persons.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
