This petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take action on the complaint submitted by the petitioner vide Annexure P-1 dated 26.07.224 against respondents No. 4 and 5 for encroaching upon the plot of the petitioner illegally and forcibly notwithstanding dismissal of stay application vide order dated 23.05.2024 (Annexure P-4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a complaint dated 26.07.2024 before the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to



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respondent No.-2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.
4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid complaint dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
