Status report dated 23.09.2024 by way of affidavit of Mr. Deepak Pareek, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

In compliance of the order dated 04.10.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, Inspector Yogesh Kumar, No.1/JRP is present in person in the Court. He submits that although the petitioner was declared innocent during the investigation but keeping in view the fact that petitioner might be summoned as an accused in this case under Section 319 Cr.PC and after release of his passport, he could run away from the country, so he made the report to the passport office. There was no intention to cause any harassment to the petitioner.

He is directed to remain careful in future and he assured the Court that in future such lapse would not be repeated by him.

Since passport has already been issued to the petitioner, so no further order is required to be passed by this Court in the present case.
