LISA GILL, J.

1. This appeal has been filed for setting aside order dated 21.07.2014, passed by learned Single Judge in CWP-13924-2014. Said writ petition was filed by appellant/writ petitioner for setting aside order dated 14.03.2014, passed by the Superintendent, Headquarter (Jails), District Gurdaspur, wherein services of appellant who was serving as Head Warder at Modern Jail, Kapurthala, were terminated while resorting to Article 311(2)(A)(B) of the Constitution of India. Learned Single Judge dismissed the said writ petition while upholding order dated 14.03.2014.
2. Present appeal was adjourned to *sine die* to await decision by learned trial Court in FIR No.202 dated 13.12.2013, registered at Police Station Maqsoodan under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985. Appellant was acquitted by learned trial Court vide judgment dated 03.03.2017. This appeal was accordingly directed to be listed for motion hearing.

3. Learned counsel for appellant submits that despite best efforts, he has been unable to contact the appellant who is not in touch with him and he has no instructions in this matter.
4. In this view of the matter, we are constrained to dismiss this appeal in default and for non-prosecution.
5. Ordered accordingly.
