1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating order dated 20.01.2023 passed by this Court in CWP 30114-2022.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Aditya Sharda, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He has placed on record a photocopy of order dated 25.08.2023 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA 1181-2023 to contend that operation of the order qua which the contempt is alleged has since been stayed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed, at this stage. .
5. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file fresh contempt petition, in case the decision of the aforesaid LPA goes in his favour.
