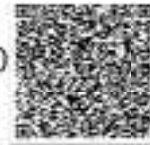

The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.3 to 5 to maintain the public street in front of the house of petitioner and other residents at Village Chaparchiri Khurd, Tehsil Mohali, District S.A.S. Nagar, which according to the petitioner, is in dilapidated condition as dirty water coming out of the drains has been blocked there, due to illegal encroachment over the public street.

2. At this stage, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having been supplied to him, and submits that the matter as regards the maintenance of the public street in front of the

house of petitioner and other residents at Village Chaparchiri Khurd, Tehsil Mohali, District S.A.S. Nagar, is under active consideration of the concerned Department and necessary action shall be taken thereupon shortly, and in any case, within a period of two months from today.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the State, submits that he does not intend to press the instant writ petition any further.
- 4. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
- 5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
