Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking compensation to the petitioner as his son namely Roshan Ali who met with an accident due to cow dung being dumped on the road as a result of which the son of the petitioner has died on the spot.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that respondent No.2 has filed its reply. He places reliance on averments contained in Para No. 8 thereof. He submits that in view of the aforesaid stand that the petitioner has an efficacious remedy to approach the Municipal Corporation for any kind of compensation, he

does not press the instant petition at this stage so as to pursue his case

before the Municipal Corporation in terms of the notification issued by the Government.
