*In the meantime, the petitioners are directed to join the
investigation and to co-operate fully with the investigation process
and on their doing so, the petitioners be released on interim bail
subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the
satisfaction of Arresting /Investigating Officer. However, the
petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when called*

upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dilbagh Singh, submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 04.09.2023 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
