1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though he was allowed the benefit of voluntarily retirement w.e.f. 30.11.2020 but his revised pensionary benefits keeping in view the recommendations of the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission have not been paid to him. Further, the prayer of the petitioner is that his service benefits should be calculated keeping in view the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission as well as the amendment to the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission done vide Notification dated 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) along with interest.
2. From the pleadings, it transpires that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the authorities concerned by way of legal notice



dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-6), which according to the petitioner is still pending consideration with the respondents.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Satnam Preet Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and will be duly conveyed to him.

5. Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction that appropriate decision on the legal notice dated 20.02.2024 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner be taken by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.
