1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying with the Order dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-8022-2023.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that as regards the petitioners who have already retired, their case for release of pensionary benefits have been forwarded to the finance department and the needful shall be done within a period of two weeks from today. He further submits that in case of petitioners those who are still in service, necessary entries in their service books with respect to their claim being covered under OPS shall be endorsed.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition at this stage and submits that the same be disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case needful is not done.
4. Ordered accordingly.
