RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 08.02.2023 passed in LPA-1307-2018.
2. Short affidavit of Anindita Mitra, Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that order dated 08.02.2023 passed in LPA-1307-2018 has since been complied with and necessary payment alongwith interest has been made to the petitioner, as would decipher from the account statement (Annexure R-1).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
