1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.62 dated 14.07.2024 under Sections 303(2), 317 (2) of B.N.S.S, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for the same offence, another FIR No. 132 dated 14.07.2024 under Section 379 and 34 of IPC, Police Station City-2, Mansa was registered against the petitioner and co-accused Bhola Singh and Ram Pal. He further contends that similarly placed co-accused Ram Pal has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 22.08.2024 in CRM-M-40527-2024. He further submits that the second FIR on the same cause of action is not maintainable. He further contends that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation in the present case.
3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. I.P.S Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. On the other hand learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner is involved in a serious offence and does not deserve the concession of bail.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

7. From the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, it is an admitted fact that another FIR No. 132 dated 14.07.2024 has already been registered at Police Station City-2, Mansa with regard to the theft of the truck and the present FIR has also been registered on the same allegations. Thus, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner may not be required in the facts and circumstances of the present case.

8. Consequently, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as provided under Sections 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S. It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call the petitioner to join the investigation, if so required, by issuing a written notice in this regard and he shall abide by the conditions mentioned in Section 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S.
