The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to release the honorarium of petitioner, who was the Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat Laduka, Block Jalalabad for the term from 01.04.2019 to 28.02.2024.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for the State has brought to the notice of this Court that proceedings under Section 216 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 are already pending against the petitioner.

2.1 Learned counsel for the State further submits that the applications (Annexures P 2 and P 3) would be considered/decided by the competent authority, in accordance with law, within a period of three months

from today.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the State, submits that he does not intend to press the instant writ petition any further.
- 4. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
