1. In the present petition, grievance of the petitioners is that their written examination paper should be evaluated as per the Appendix-J (Annexure P1-A), which was in existence at the time of holding of written examination rather than on the basis of the criteria, which is contrary to the rules governing the service(Annexure P/1).

2. Mr. Anoop Singh Malik, Joint Director, appears on behalf of the respondents and submits that claim of the petitioners has already been accepted and their written examination papers will be evaluated on the basis of criteria, which was fixed as per Appendix-J and was in operation at the time of holding of written examination and the result will be declared accordingly.

3. One of the petitioner in CWP-23253-2022 namely, Yogesh Saroha, appears in person and submits that keeping in view the statement made on behalf of the respondents grievance of the petitioners have already been satisfied but one of his paper has not been marked correctly for which he has already submitted a representation to the authority concerned and prays that the said representation may kindly be decided.

4. Mr. Anoop Singh Malik, Joint Director, who appears for the respondents submits that representation filed by the petitioner, has already been forwarded to the authority concerned and appropriate decision will be taken by the authority concerned within a period of 02 weeks from today and in case petitioner-Yogesh Saroha is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed by the respondents.

5. Keeping in view the facts as recorded hereinbefore, as the relief claimed by the petitioners in the present petition has already been extended to them, the present petition has already been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such with the observations as made hereinbefore.

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Present application is also disposed of.
